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1. Overview

Insife “HALOPV” 4.0.1 is a minor release enhancing the capabilities of HALOPV 4.0. It contains a small number of updates as detailed in section 3 to support some legislative updates, along with some other key identified issues and new/ updated features.

1.1. Upgradability

HALOPV 4.0.1 can be upgraded from any previous HALOPV release. It can also be deployed as a standalone full installation.

2. Compatibility

HALOPV 4.0.1 is compatible with the following systems:

- Argus 8.2.1.1 and Argus 8.2.3 (Please contact us for compatibility with earlier/ later versions)
- ARISg 7.2 (Please contact us for compatibility with earlier/ later versions)
- Browser Compatibility

HALOPV requires a JavaScript enabled browser and supports the current and prior major release of **Google Chrome**, **Mozilla Firefox**, and **Microsoft Edge**. HALOPV leverages Oracle APEX framework and is compatible with browsers supported by it.

OBS: Support of **Microsoft Internet Explorer** was no longer supported from HALOPV 4.0
